A Sydney-born actor of Irish-Australian heritage, Ciarán finished full-time training at Actors Centre Australia in 2020 and has been a proud member of MEAA every year since. He made his start in student theatre in 2015 performing as Davey in The Lieutenant of Inishmore (NUTS), and Daniel in Ian Meadows' Between Two Waves (NUTS). As part of ACA's Graduating Company, he performed Andrew Aguecheek in Twelfth Night (dir. Adam Cook), Tom in Fat Pig (dir. Frankie Savige) and Dean in Gloria (dir. Troy Harrison), Silvius in As You Like It (dir. Adam Cook) and contributed to a self-devised production of Sarah Kane's 4:48 Psychosis with members of the company.

Since graduating, he has played Points in Henry IV Part One and Two (Streamed Shakespeare), Pericles in Pericles of Tyre (The Acting Factory), Lysander in A Midsummer Night's Dream (The Acting Factory), Pistol in Merry Wives of Windsor (New Theatre), Dom in What Have You Done (Chippen St) and starred in Sydney The Folk Musical for Newcastle Fringe (dir. Clark Gormley). He has also adapted and directed a pop-up production of Chaucer's Canterbury Tales.
